IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize and ratify the appointment of Portland  
City Hall Building Commission.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The order and action of the city council of the  
2 City of Portland constituting Adam P. Leighton, John F.  
3 A. Merrill and Richard C. Payson and their successors as  
4 therein specified, and any succeeding mayor of said city  
5 *ex officio*, a commission to build a new city hall building  
6 and auditorium, together with the powers and duties enu-  
7 merated in said order, are hereby authorized and ratified.  
8 Said commission may call and receive bids and proposals for  
9 erecting said buildings, and in the name and on behalf of the

10 city execute such contracts therefor as the city council shall  
11 authorize, and shall see that the same are faithfully and  
12 promptly performed. Money appropriated by said city  
13 council for erecting said buildings shall be paid out only on  
14 the written approval of said commission, or a majority  
15 thereof; and a report of its work and expenditures shall be  
16 made at such stated times as the city council may require.  
17 The members of said commission shall receive only such  
18 compensation for their services as said city council may  
19 vote.
