IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Mattagamon Manufacturing Company.

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Mat2 tagamon Manufacturing Company which were granted by
3 chapter two hundred seventy-nine of the Private and Special
4 Laws of nineteen hundred one and by chapter forty-seven
5 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred three
6 and by chapter ninety-nine of the Private and Special Laws
7 of nineteen hundred five and by chapter twenty-eight of the
8 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred seven are
9 hereby extended, and the persons named in said act, their
10 associates, successors and assigns, shall have all the rights,

11 powers and privileges that were granted them by said acts, 12 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-13 poses as specified in said acts.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
