STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, Providing for the Payment of Claims, Accounts, and Demands against the State, Accrued prior to January 1, 1909, and Remaining Unpaid by Reason of Insufficient Appropriations.

Resolved: That for the purpose of paying the several 2 claims, accounts and demands against the State, accrued 3 prior to, and remaining unpaid on January first, nineteen 4 hundred and nine, by reason of insufficient appropriations, as 5 reported to the Legislature, by communication from the 6 State Auditor under date of January fifteenth, nineteen hun- 7 dred and nine, in compliance with Section five of Chapter 8 one hundred and forty-seven, of the Public Laws of nine- 9 teen hundred and seven, there be and hereby is appropriated 10 the sum of one hundred two thousand, eight hundred sev- 11 enty-four dollars, eighty-one cents, to be paid the several 12 persons, firms and corporations named in said communica- 13 tion, respectively, the amounts therein reported, as follows:
