STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to enable the Sebago Lake, Songo River and Bay of Naples Steamboat Company to construct and maintain a wharf at the east shore of Sebago Lake, in the town of Raymond, in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Sebago Lake, Songo River and Bay of
2 Naples Steamboat Company, a corporation duly established
3 and existing under the laws of the State, its successors and
4 assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to construct
5 and maintain a wharf in Raymond, near South Casco, at the
6 east shore of Sebago Lake in the town of Raymond in the
7 County of Cumberland, and at a point in said Raymond
8 where the present so-called South Casco Wharf (now owned

9 and used by the said Sebago Lake, Songo River and Bay of
10 Naples Steamboat Company) is built, the location of said
11 wharf to be established by the County Commissioners of
12 Cumberland County, and to extend the same at a sufficient
13 length and width into the water to allow the landing of boats
14 and steamers at said wharf.

Sect. 2. And for the purposes aforesaid the said corpora-
2 tion is hereby authorized to acquire by purchase, grant or
3 gift from any person or corporation, any lands, shore rights,
4 rights of way from streets or highways, to said wharf; said
5 corporation may also for the purposes aforesaid, take by
6 right of eminent domain, any land, shore right, rights of way
7 from streets or highways, to said wharf, in the same manner
8 and under the same conditions, restrictions and limitations,
9 as are by law prescribed in the case of taking land for the
10 laying out of highways, upon payment of reasonable com-
11 pensation therefor.

Sect. 3. Said corporation shall be held liable to pay a just
2 compensation for the taking of the lands, shore rights, rights
3 of way from streets or highways to said wharf, and if any
4 person sustaining damage for property so as aforesaid taken,
5 and said corporation shall not mutually agree upon the sum
6 to be paid therefor, such person may cause his damage to
7 be ascertained in the same manner and under the same con-
8 ditions, restrictions, limitations, as are by law prescribed in
9 the case of damages by the laying out of highways.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
