IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT prohibiting the exhibit of Moving Pictures in any  
city or town without a license.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever, for money or other valuable article,  
2 exhibits moving pictures of any kind in any city or town,  
3 shall first obtain a license from the municipal officers of the  
4 city or town where such pictures are exhibited, and shall  
5 pay therefor such sum as the municipal officers shall deem  
6 proper. Any person exhibiting moving pictures without  
7 such license, shall be fined ten dollars for each day such pic-  
8 tures are so exhibited.
