STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section eighty-five of Chapter fifteen of the
Revised Statutes relating to payment for teachers' services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section eighty-five of Chapter fifteen is hereby
2 amended by striking out the words between the word
3 "school" in line seven and the word "properly" in line eight
4 and inserting in place thereof the following: "Teachers shall
5 be paid for their services at the close of each school month,
6 but no teacher shall receive final payment for services for
7 any term until the register herein described;" so that said
8 section, when amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 85. Every teacher of a public school shall keep
10 a register thereof, containing the names of all the scholars

11 who enter the school, their ages, the dates of each scholar's
12 entering and leaving, the number of days during which each
13 attended, the length of the school, the teacher's wages, a list
14 of text-books used, and all other facts required by the blank
15 forms furnished him; such register shall at all times be open
16 to the inspection of the school committee, and be returned to
17 them at the close of the school. Teachers shall be paid for
18 their services at the close of each school month, but no teach-
19 er shall receive final payment for services for any term until
20 the register herein described, properly filled, completed, and
21 signed, is deposited with the school committee, or with the
22 person designated by them to receive it.'
