STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Trull Hospital Aid Association.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of two thousand dollars to be paid to the Trull Hos-
3 pital Aid Association, a corporation at Biddeford, York
4 County, Maine. One thousand dollars of said sum to be
5 for the use of said corporation for the year nineteen hun-
6 dred nine and one thousand dollars to be for the use of
7 said corporation for the year nineteen hundred ten.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Trull Hospital Aid Association of the city of Biddeford was organized for the purpose of assisting worthy and needy people to secure medical and surgical treatment and the services of trained nurses at the Trull Hospital located in Biddeford. The association has raised substantial sums of money by dues from its own members and from other sources. It asks aid from the State that it may enlarge the charity work heretofore and now carried on by it as well as by the employment of a district nurse, whose services may be available in the homes of people who are themselves unable to procure the same.
