STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the purpose of operating the fish hatcheries
and feeding stations for fish and for the protection of fish.

Resolved, That the sum of forty-seven thousand five hun-
2 dred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the year nine-
3 teen hundred and nine and also forty-seven thousand five
4 hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten to
5 be expended by the commissioners of inland fisheries and
6 game, under the direction of the Governor and council, for
7 the purpose of operating the fish hatcheries and feeding
8 stations for fish in the State and for the protection of fish.

Provided, also, that the commissioners of inland fisheries
10 and game may purchase or lease real estate in the name of
11 the State for the purpose of maintaining fish hatcheries and

12 feeding stations and erecting the same for fish culture, and
13 may also assist in maintaining fish hatcheries for fish culture
14 owned and under the management of fish and game asso-
15 ciations, provided, also, that the commissioners shall make
16 a detailed statement in their report of all expenditures of
17 money expended under this resolve.
