RESOLVE for the purpose of erecting a fish hatchery in Knox County.

Resolved, That the sum of three thousand dollars be and 2 is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and 3 nine and two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and tend and tend tend for the purpose of erecting a suitable fish 5 hatchery for the artificial propagation of fish and restocking 6 the waters of Knox county and vicinity, the same to be 7 erected at some point in said Knox county to be hereafter 8 determined by the commissioners of inland fisheries and 9 game, the same to be expended by the commissioners of 10 inland fisheries and game.
