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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend section thirty-four of chapter fifteen of  
the Revised Statutes relating to the election of the superin-  
tendent of schools.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section thirty-four of chapter fifteen is hereby  
2 amended by inserting between the word "committee" in  
3 line five and the word "this" in line five the following:  
4 'Provided however, that any town may at its annual town  
5 meeting elect a superintendent of schools.' So that said  
6 section, when amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 34. The management of the schools and the custody  
8 and care, including repairs and insurance on school build-  
9 ings, of all school property in every town, shall devolve

10 upon the superintending school committee which shall an-  
11 nually, and as often as a vacancy shall occur, elect a super-  
12 intendent of schools who shall not be a member of the com-  
13 mittee. Provided however, that any town may at its annual  
14 town meeting elect a superintendent of schools. This sec-  
15 tion shall not apply to cities, nor to towns authorized by  
16 special laws to employ or choose superintendents in manner  
17 otherwise as herein provided.'
