### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section one hundred and fifteen of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to Public Schools.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section one hundred and fifteen of Chapter 2 fifteen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by sub-3 stituting for the words "forty thousand" in line two the 4 words "sixty-two thousand five hundred," and by substituting for the word "four" in line three the word "nine," 6 and by substituting for the words "forty-three thousand" in 7 lines three and four the words "sixty-two thousand five hun-8 dred," so that said section, when amended, shall read as fol-9 lows:

'Sect. 115. For the support of the four normal schools and 11 the Madawaska Training School, the sum of sixty-two thou12 sand five hundred dollars is appropriated for the year nine13 teen hundred and nine and the sum of sixty-two thousand 14 five hundred dollars is annually appropriated thereafter, to be 15 expended under the direction of said trustees, which sum 16 the treasurer of state shall deduct for said purpose from any 17 school money raised for the support of common schools. 18 The governor and council may from time to time, as they 19 think proper, draw warrants therefor on said treasurer in 20 favor of said trusttes.'
