IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section sixty-four of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes relating to the tuition of pupils in secondary schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section sixty-four of Chapter fifteen is hereby 2 amended by inserting after the word "schools" in line three 3 of said section the words "before the first day of September 4 for the preceding school year," so that said section when 5 amended shall read as follows:—

'Section 64. When any town shall have been required to 7 pay and has paid tuition as aforesaid the superintending 8 school committee of such town shall make a return under 9 oath to the State superintendent of public schools before the

10 first day of September for the preceding school year, stating
11 the name of each youth for whom tuition has been paid, the
12 amount paid for each, and the name and location of the
13 school which each has attended and thereupon shall be paid,
14 annually in the month of December, from the State treasury
15 out of the appropriation for the support of free high schools,
16 to each town paying tuition and making return as aforesaid,
17 a sum equal to one-half of the amount thus paid by such
18 town not exceeding two hundred fifty dollars.'
