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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend Section twenty-eight of Chapter fifteen of  
the Revised Statutes relating to the duties of the municipal  
officers of towns.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Paragraph III of Section twenty-eight of Chap-  
2 ter fifteen is hereby amended by striking out the words "last  
3 school year" in line two of said paragraph of said section  
4 and inserting in place thereof the words "preceding fiscal  
5 year of the town;" paragraph IV of section twenty-eight is  
6 hereby amended by adding thereto the words "at the expira-  
7 tion of the preceding fiscal year of the town;" so that said  
8 section, when amended, shall read as follows:—

'Section 28. The assessors or municipal officers of each

10 town, shall, on or before the first day of each May, make to  
11 the State superintendent of public schools, a certificate, un-  
12 der oath, embracing the following items:

I. The amount voted by the town for the common schools  
14 at the preceding annual meeting.

II. The amount of school moneys payable to the town  
16 from the State treasury during the year ending with the first  
17 day of the preceding April.

III. The amount of money actually expended for common  
19 schools during the preceding fiscal year of the town.

IV. The amount of school moneys unexpended at the ex-  
21 piration of the preceding fiscal year of the town.

V. Answers to such inquiries as are presented to secure  
23 a full and complete statement of school revenues and expen-  
24 ditures.'
