STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to make uniform the standard relating to the per-
centage of alcohol in intoxicating liquors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Alcoholic liquors which may not be sold except
2 by payment of a revenue tax to the United States Govern-
3 ment are hereby declared to be intoxicating liquors within
4 the meaning of all statutes of this State.
