IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 153 of the public laws of
1907, relating to the issuance and acceptance of free transpor-
tation by State officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 153 of the public laws of
2 1907 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

“This section shall not apply to employees of any State fish
4 hatchery or feeding station while going from said hatchery
5 in charge of fish to be planted in any of the public waters of
6 the State, or returning from such a trip.”
