STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of Freedom Academy.

Resolved: That there be paid to the Trustees of Freedom
2 Academy the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to par-
3 tially reimburse the aforesaid trustees for the excess cost of
4 construction of the new dormitory, for the use of the
5 Academy, over the original calculation. Said amount to be
6 paid in two installments; five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to
7 be paid on August 1st, 1909, and five hundred dollars
8 (\$500.00) to be paid on August 1st, 1910.
