STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of Eastern State Normal School at Castine.

Resolved: That the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for
2 the year nineteen hundred and nine and the sum of twenty
3 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, be
4 and hereby is appropriated for the erection and furnishing
5 of a dormitory for the Eastern State Normal School, said
6 sums to be expended under the direction of the board of
7 trustees of State Normal Schools.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In order that the Eastern State Normal School may continue its good work a dormitory for the accommodation of the students is absolutely necessary. As conditions are now all the students are placed at a great inconvenience in the matter of board and lodging. Formerly there were many boarding places, but in the past few years these for many reasons have been growing gradually less so that at this time there are very few desirable places for room and board and the Principal of the school has great difficulty in obtaining suitable accommodations for the students.
