AN ACT to amend Section forty-one of chapter forty-nine of
the Revised Statutes, relating to insurance policies.

Section forty-one of chapter forty-nine of the Revised

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

2 Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word “ac-
3 cident” in the second line of paragraph five thereof the
4 words “or illness;” also by adding to said paragraph the
5 following: “And no contract of insurance against illness by
6 any insurance company doing business in this State shall be
7 made to relate to such illness as may be contracted not more
8 than six days after the date of such contract,” so that said
9 paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

“V. To insure any person against bodily injury or death
11 by accident or illness, or any person, firm or corporation
12 against loss or damage on account of the bodily injury or
13 death by accident of any person for which loss or damage
14 said person, firm or corporation is responsible. “And no
15 contract of insurance against illness by any insurance com-
16 pany doing business in this State shall be made to relate
17 to such illness as may be contracted not more than six days
18 after the date of such contract.”
