IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Investment Trust Com-
pany.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the In-
2 vestment Company, located at Portland, Cumberland County,
3 Maine, which were granted by Chapter two hundred thirteen
4 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and
5 seven, approved March 13, 1907, are hereby extended for
6 one year, from the approval of this act; and the persons
7 named in said act, their associates and successors shall have
8 all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by
9 said original act, to be exercised in the same manner and
10 for the same purposes as specified therein; provided, how-
11 ever, that said company shall actually commence business as
12 a trust company within said one year.
