STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Stonington Electric Light
and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Ston-
2 ington Electric Light and Power Company, which were
3 granted by Chapter two hundred and seventy of the Pri-
4 vate and Special Laws of the State of Maine for the year
5 nineteen hundred and seven, are hereby extended for two
6 years, and the persons named in said act, their associates
7 and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and priv-
8 ileges that were granted to them by said act, to be exercised
9 in the same manner and for the same purposes specified in
10 said act.
