STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital,
for concrete walk, grading, painting, furnishings, completion
of contracts on barn, tubercular hospital and Wing D.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of thirty-eight thousand one hundred forty-nine dollars
3 and eighty-eight cents, for the use of the Eastern Maine
4 Insane Hospital in nineteen hundred and nine, for the fol-
5 lowing purposes:

For the construction of concrete walks and water shed
7 around new buildings, for grading, for painting and fur-
8 nishing new buildings, and for completion of contracts on
9 barn, tubercular hospital and Wing D.

Said sums to be expended under direction of Trustees of
11 Insane Hospitals.

For concrete walk and watershed, for roof dripings	\$ 600 00
Grading—Amount required to establish proper grades around Wing D and tubercular hospital	2,000 00
Painting—Amount required to paint Wing D and tubercular hospital	4,000 00
Furnishings—Including all furniture, bedding, dining-room equipment, kitchen utensils, telephone and watch-clock system:	
Tubercular hospital	4,500 00
Wing D	13,700 00
Wing D—Amount expended in excess and necessary to complete the building	7,499 82
Tubercular hospital—Amount expended in excess and necessary to complete the building	3,754 13
Barn—Amount expended in excess and necessary to complete the building	2,095 93
Total	\$38,149 88
