SEVENTY-FOURTH LEGISLATURE SENATE. No. 241

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital, for completion of the criminal insane building.

Whereas, delay in the completion and furnishing of the criminal insane building of the Maine Insane Hospital will occasion continued hazard and inconvenience to the management of said institution in the performance of its duty to properly guard and care for the criminal insane of the State; and whereas, in the opinion of this Legislature, these facts constitute this resolve an emergency measure which is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety; now therefore be it

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated, the 2 sum of twelve thousand dollars for the year nineteen hun-3 dred and nine, for the use of the Maine Insane Hospital, 4 for the following purposes: For the completion and furnishing of the criminal insane 6 building.

Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Trus-8 tees of Insane Hospitals.

In view of the emergency set forth in the preamble, this 10 resolve shall take effect when approved.
