RESOLVE for the appointment by the Governor of a Committee to inquire into the advisability of reorganizing the Agricultural Department, so that all of the agricultural interests and appropriations shall be under the head of the Commissioner of Agriculture.

---

*Resolved,* That a special committee of three be appointed, 2 two of which shall be of the Governor's Council, to inquire 3 into the advisability of reorganizing the Agricultural De- 4 partment, so that all of the agricultural interests and appro- 5 priations shall be under the head of the Commissioner of 6 Agriculture.

*Resolved,* That said committee have power to summon 8 witnesses, demand the production of papers and documents, 9 and be authorized to set after the adjournment of the pres- 10 ent legislative session. The said committee shall report, 11 by bill or otherwise, which report shall be filed with the
