RESOLVE in favor of W. A. Walker.

Resolved, That the sum of sixty dollars and thirty-four
2 cents (\$60.34) be paid W. A. Walker, Chairman of Joint
3 Committee on State Prison, to defray expenses incurred by
4 him on account of visit of said committee to the Maine
5 State Prison at Thomaston, also for expense incurred in
6 visiting the University of Maine as a member of the Com-
7 mittee on Education.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The expense incurred by the Committee on State Prison was \$57.00, being for railroad fares, hotel bills, electric car fare and telephone charges, while visiting the State Prison at Thomaston. The expense incurred in visiting the University of Maine was \$3.34, all of which was for car fare from Augusta to Orono and return.
