STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide for the expenses of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to be
2 paid the Maine Industrial School for Girls the sum of
3 eighteen thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred
4 nine and the sum of eighteen thousand dollars for the year
5 nineteen hundred ten for general expenses; also the sum of
6 three thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred nine
7 for deficiency of the year nineteen hundred eight.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The sums asked for for general expenses are intended to cover the cost of maintenance of the school, including salaries, treasurer's bond, insurance, postage, printing, stationery, etc.
