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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend section eleven of chapter two hundred and eleven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five relating to Bangor Municipal Court.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section eleven of chapter two hundred and eleven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

‘Sect. 11. Said court shall be held at such place as the city of Bangor shall provide and said city shall have power and it shall be its duty to raise money and provide a proper place for said court and its officers and suitably furnish, warm and light the same, for which there shall be paid

9 from the county of Penobscot, as rental, in quarterly pay-  
10 ments, the sum of one thousand dollars annually. The sala-  
11 ries of the judge and clerk thereof, which are hereby fixed  
12 at fifteen hundred dollars and fourteen hundred and fifty  
13 dollars respectively, to be paid quarterly, with all other  
14 expenses of said court, shall be paid from the treasury of  
15 the county of Penobscot. Said clerk shall also annually  
16 receive six hundred and fifty dollars for clerk hire, or so  
17 much thereof as may be necessary, payable in the same  
18 manner and from the same source as his salary.”
