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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fifteen of the  
Private and Special Laws of the year eighteen hundred and  
seventy-two, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Home for  
Aged Women at Bangor."

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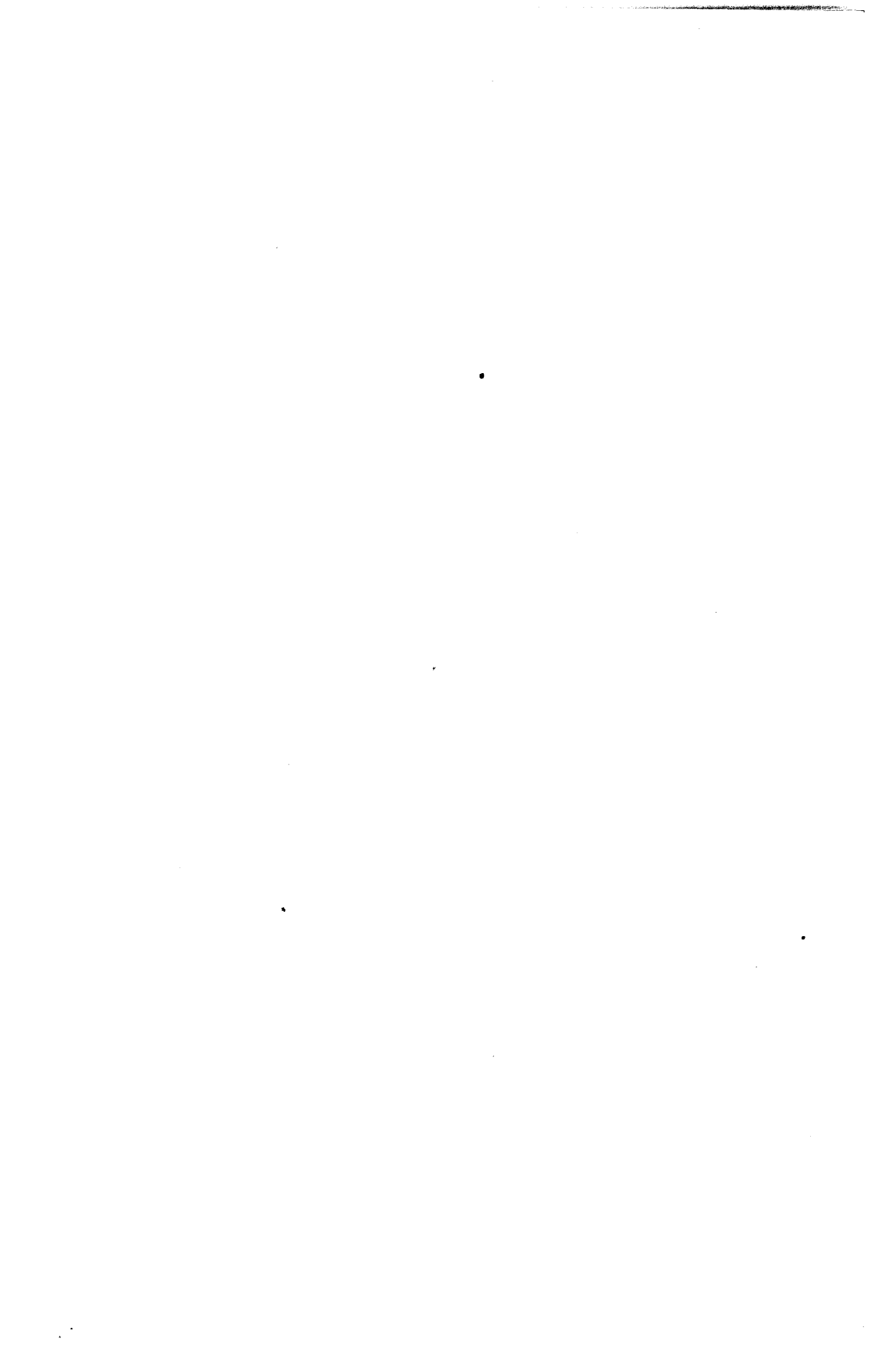
*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and fifteen  
2 of the private and special laws of the year eighteen hundred  
3 and seventy-two, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Home  
4 for Aged Women at Bangor," is hereby amended by strik-  
5 ing out the word "one" in the third line of said section and  
6 substituting therefor the word 'five,' so that said section as  
7 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. The said corporation may take by purchase, de-

9 vise or otherwise, any real or personal property, and hold  
10 the same for the purposes aforesaid, to any amount not  
11 exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, exempt from tax-  
12 ation, and may manage and dispose of the same according  
13 to their discretion.”

Sect. 2. The acts and doings of said corporation in here-  
2 tofore receiving bequests and legacies, either or both, in  
3 excess of the amount which it was authorized to hold by its  
4 charter is hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid in all  
5 respects, and said corporation is hereby authorized to receive  
6 any legacies or bequests made to it in any will which has  
7 been admitted to probate, provided the total amount held  
8 by said corporation shall not exceed the sum of five hun-  
9 dred thousand dollars.
