STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend and additional to Chapter 50 of the Private
and Special Laws of 1866, relating to the Children's Home
in Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The name of the Children's Home of Bangor
2 is hereby changed to Bangor Children's Home, and said
3 corporation has its legal residence at Bangor in the County
4 of Penobscot and State of Maine.

Sect. 2. Said corporation exists for the charitable purpose
2 of providing and carrying into effect means for the support
3 and employment of destitute children, especially orphans.

Sect. 3. Said corporation may receive and hold all kinds
2 of property already acquired or to be acquired by it for the

3 charitable purposes aforesaid, without any limit of value
4 thereof and without any limit of the annual income received
5 or to be received by said corporation.

Sect. 4. Said corporation is entitled to any gifts, devises
2 or conveyances heretofore or hereafter made to it in the
3 name of Children's Home of Bangor, Bangor Children's
4 Home or Orphans' Home of Bangor.
