## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of E. L. Philoon, Chairman of Joint Special Committee appointed by the Seventy-third Legislature.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of five hundred seventy-four dollars and seventy cents be and is hereby appropriated, to be paid to E. L. Philoon, of Auburn, chairman of the special joint committee appointed by the Seventy-third Legislature of Maine to consider the advisability of establishing a Board of Education, to reimburse him for the actual cash expenses of said committee, and of each member thereof, incurred in the discharge of their official duties.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The committee consisted of Messrs. Philoon of Androscoggin and Rice of Franklin, of the Senate, and Messrs. Danforth of Skowhegan, Knowlton of Monson, and Murphy of Portland, of the House. Their itemized bills for expenses incurred, including services of stenographer, accompany this resolve, and amount to the sum of \$574.70.
