STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Receiver of the Eustis Railroad Com-
pany to dispose of the property of said Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Receiver of the Eustis Railroad Company
2 is hereby authorized under the direction of the Court having
3 jurisdiction of the proceedings in which he was appointed, to
4 abandon the operation of said railroad and take up and re-
5 move and sell and convey as personal property the rails, ties,
6 switches and all other fixtures of said railroad including
7 buildings, and to sell and convey all the personal property
8 including engines, cars and other rolling stock and all the
9 real estate of said railroad; and neither said receiver nor

10 purchaser at such sale as the Court may order shall be under
11 any obligation to maintain and operate said railroad or any
12 part thereof, and shall hold said property fully discharged
13 from any such obligation.

Sect. 2. Said receiver is hereby further authorized under
2 the direction of said Court to sell and convey said railroad
3 with and subject to the right for and in said purchaser to
4 abandon the operation of all or any part of said railroad and
5 to take up and remove from said railroad or from such part
6 as may be abandoned and to sell and convey, as personal
7 property, the rails, ties, switches and all other fixtures of said
8 railroad, including buildings, and to sell and convey all or
9 any part of the engines, cars, and other rolling stock, and
10 all or any part of the real estate of said railroad; and such
11 purchaser at such sale shall not be under any obligation to
12 maintain and operate said railroad and shall hold the rail-
13 road purchased from said receiver as aforesaid fully dis-
14 charged from any such obligation to maintain and operate.

Sect. 3. Said receiver in case of and after any abandon-
2 ment by him and said purchaser in case of and after any
3 abandonment by said purchaser shall prepare in duplicate
4 a certificate setting forth the fact of abandonment and
5 whether all or a part has been abandoned and, if a part, a
6 general description thereof and file one of the copies of said
7 certificate in the office of the Railroad Commissioners and
8 one in the office of the Secretary of State.
