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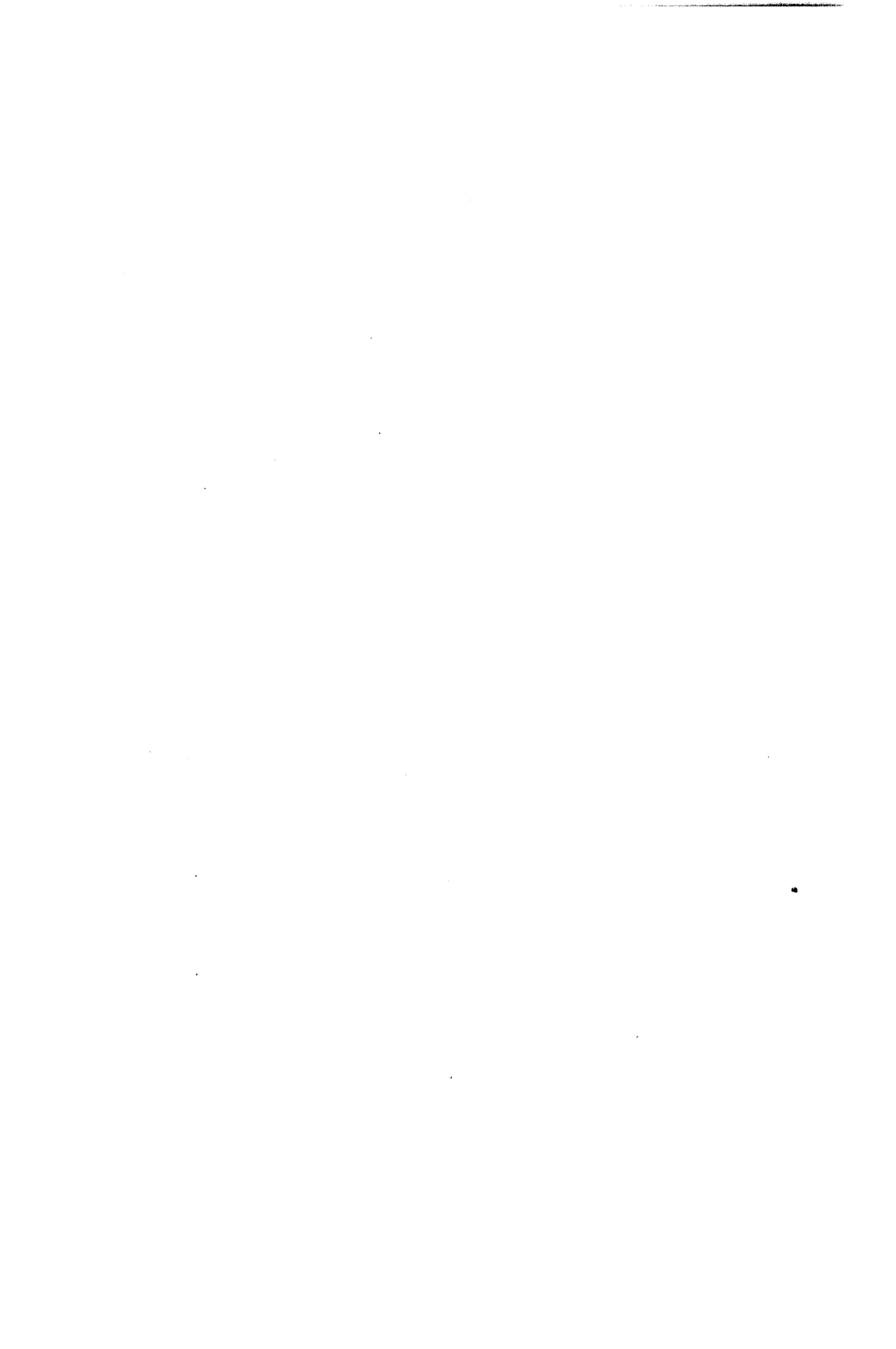
AN ACT to extend the charter of the Wells Electric Light and  
Power Company.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Wells  
2 Electric Light and Power Company, which were granted by  
3 chapter three hundred and five of the Private and Special  
4 Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, are hereby extended  
5 for two years from the passage of this act; and the per-  
6 sons named in said act, their associates and successors, shall  
7 have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted  
8 them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner and  
9 for the same purposes as specified in said act.
