AN ACT to extend the charter of the Wells Telephone
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Wells
2 Telephone Company, which were granted by Chapter three
3 hundred and seven, of the Private and Special Laws of nine-
4 teen hundred and seven, are hereby extended for two years
5 from the passage of this act; and the persons named in said
6 act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights,
7 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act,
8 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-
9 poses as specified in said act.
