STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the Madawaska Training School.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum
2 of twelve hundred dollars for the Madawaska Training
3 School for purchasing land to be used by said school, six
4 hundred dollars being for the year nineteen hundred and
5 nine, and six hundred for the year nineteen hundred and
6 ten and that the same be expended under the direction of
7 the Normal School Trustees.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

An appropriation of twelve hundred dollars is required for the Madawaska Training School, located at Fort Kent, Maine, for the purpose of buying land near the school buildings, to be used for the classes in agriculture and for a play ground. The land can now be bought for the above sum of twelve hundred dollars. More land is absolutely needed by the school, and this is the most available that can be obtained.
