STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to appropriate moneys for the payment of salaries fixed by law for the year one thousand nine hundred and nine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In order to provide for the payment of sal-2 aries fixed by law, for the current fiscal year one thousand 3 nine hundred and nine, the following sums are hereby ap-4 propriated out of any moneys in the State Treasury, and, 5 except where otherwise specially provided, the Governor 6 with the advice and consent of the Council, is hereby au-7 thorized at any time prior to the first day of January, one 8 thousand nine hundred and ten, to draw his warrant on the 9 State Treasurer for the same.
