IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

---

AN ACT to prohibit the hunting of ducks and other water fowl  
in Damariscotta Pond, in Lincoln county, by use of steam,  
naphtha or gasoline boats.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person at any time  
2 in any boat propelled by steam, naphtha, gasoline, electricity,  
3 or any power other than sail or hand power, in the waters of  
4 Damariscotta pond, to chase, hunt, gun or shoot any sea  
5 bird, ducks, or water fowl under a penalty of not less than  
6 twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars and  
7 costs for each offense.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions arising under this act, municipi-  
2 pal and police courts and trial justices, within their respective

3 counties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent  
4 jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts, and all  
5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for violation of this  
6 act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving the same  
7 to the State treasurer, and credited to fines and license fees  
8 for the protection of birds and game.
