# STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to Documentary History of Maine.

Whereas, the Maine Historical Society proposes to publish annually a volume in a series of volumes containing the earliest documents, charters and other State papers illustrating the history of Maine; and

Whereas the funds of the society derivable from its annual income are insufficient for this purpose; and whereas, other states have, at great expense, procured and published their documentary history at the public expense, therefore,

Resolved, That the Maine Historical Society, agreeing to 2 supervise the copying, attesting, editing, indexing and pub-3 lishing of volumes thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and sixteen of 4 the Documentary History of Maine in the same manner 20

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5 volumes eleven and twelve of said Documentary History, 6 published under the resolves approved February twenty-six, 7 nineteen hundred and seven; the Governor and Council shall 8 purchase for the State five hundred copies of each of said 9 volumes at two dollars and fifty cents per volume, said vol-10 umes to be distributed or exchanged at the discretion of the 11 State Librarian.
