STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Concord, County of Somerset.

Resolved, That the sum of nine hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated to aid the town of Concord in building
3 and repairing the highway leading to the Concord bridge, to
4 be expended under the direction of an agent appointed by
5 the governor and council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The highway for which this appropriation is asked is a main thoroughfare leading to Concord bridge. Before approaching the bridge is a very steep hill and a ledge of about 100 ft. is located on one side. It is necessary to remove a portion of this ledge in order to make the road safe and allow teams to pass and turn around before crossing the bridge. The town of Concord is not able at the present time to pay for the repairs in question.
