AN ACT authorizing the location of a dam built by Edward  
S. Marshall of York, under license of the municipal officers  
of said town.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The location and construction of the pier or  
2 dam built by Edward S. Marshall, in the tide waters of  
3 York river, in the town of York, pursuant to license granted  
4 by the municipal officers of said town, under sections ninety-  
5 six and ninety-eight of chapter four of the Revised Statutes,  
6 and approved by the secretary of war and chief of engineers,  
7 is hereby authorized and ratified.
