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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend Section 32 of Chapter 8 of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter 156 of the Public Laws of 1907, relating to excise tax on palaces or other cars, for which extra compensation is charged for riding therein.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 32 of Chapter 8 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter 156 of the Public Laws of 1907, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "four and one-half" in the sixth line and inserting in place thereof the word 'six'; so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 32. Every corporation or person owning or operating palaces or other cars for which extra compensation is

9 charged for riding therein over any of the railroads of the  
10 State shall annually on the first day of September, pay to  
11 the treasurer of state for the use of the State an annual  
12 excise tax for the privilege of exercising its franchises in  
13 the State, equal to six per cent of its or his gross receipts  
14 from business done wholly in the State, for the year end-  
15 ing June thirtieth next preceding.'
