IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relative to school outhouses.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the superintending school  
2 committee to provide at least two suitable and convenient  
3 outhouses or water closets for each school building. Said  
4 outhouses or water closets shall have separate means of ac-  
5 cess. The superintending school committee shall have said  
6 outhouses and water closets kept in a clean and suitable con-  
7 dition. Towns shall appropriate a sum of money sufficient  
8 to enable said superintending school committee to comply  
9 with the provisions of this act.
