AN ACT to authorize the construction of a bridge across the  
Ogunquit River, in the town of Wells.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Authority is hereby granted to the town of  
2 Wells, or the County Commissioners of York County, to  
3 construct a bridge, with necessary approaches across tide  
4 waters in the Ogunquit River at some convenient point near  
5 land of Geo. L. Fowler in the town of Wells.
