RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Smyrna, appropriating \$258.64 to reimburse the town of Smyrna for money paid out on account of State paupers.

*Resolved,* That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum  
2 of ninety-five dollars and seventy-five cents to reimburse the  
3 town of Smyrna for money paid for State paupers during the  
4 year 1908.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

During the year 1908 the town of Smyrna expended the following sums for State paupers as per vouchers presented herewith:

Dec., 1908, Eveline Mitchell .....	83 75

Through the error of the town officials in failing to present the bills to the State in the proper form or on the proper dates, they have not been paid in the usual way and this resolve is presented for the purpose of reimbursing the town.
