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AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-eight of the Public Laws of 1907, entitled "An Act to encourage the compiling and teaching of local history and local geography in the public schools."

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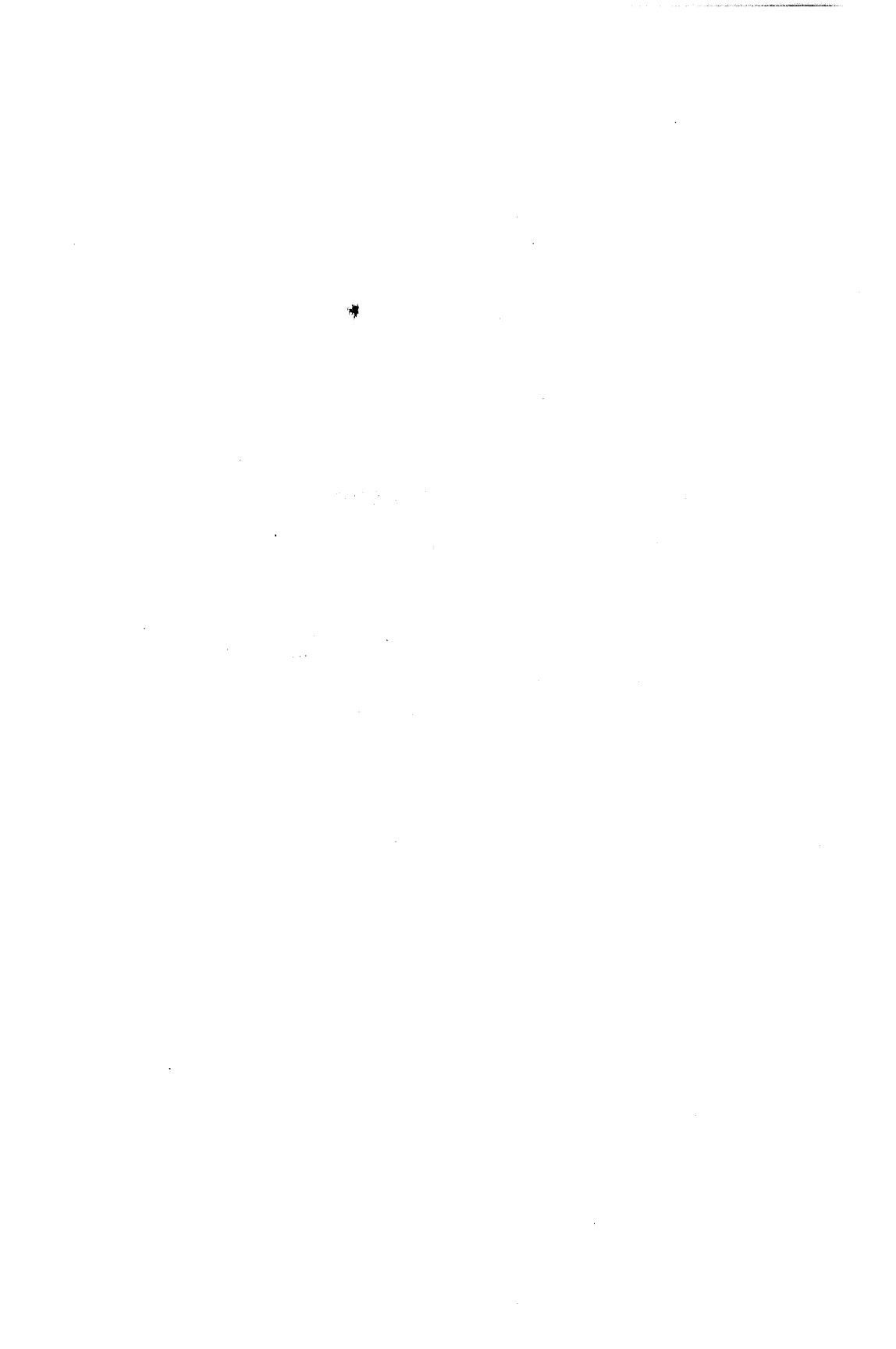
*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter eighty-eight of the Public Laws of 2 1907 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following 3 sections:

'Sect. 6. The State historian is authorized to expend, 5 under the direction of the governor and council, any por- 6 tion of the amount appropriated by this act, in the publi-

7 cation of historical matter and data relating to the history  
8 of Maine.'

'Sect. 7. The marking of historical sites, as authorized  
10 by the legislature, shall be under the direction of the State  
11 historian.'
