STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT in relation to the records of the Supreme Judicial
Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Supreme Judicial Court in any county,
2 when justice or the public good requires it, may order the
3 expunging from the records of and papers on file in any
4 case which has gone to judgment, of any name or other part
5 thereof unnecessary to the purpose and effect of said judg-
6 ment.

Sect. 2. Upon the entering of such order the clerk of
2 courts shall expunge such name or part from the records
3 and papers by wholly obliterating the same.
