IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Private and Special Laws of 1901, Chapter
401, Section 2, relating to the taking of smelts in Pleasant
river, in Washington county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 401 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1901 is hereby amended by striking out
3 the word "twentieth" in the second line of said section and
4 substituting therefor the word "first" so that said section, as
5 amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 2. No smelts shall be taken or fished for except
7 by hook and line between the first day of May and the first
8 day of October.'
