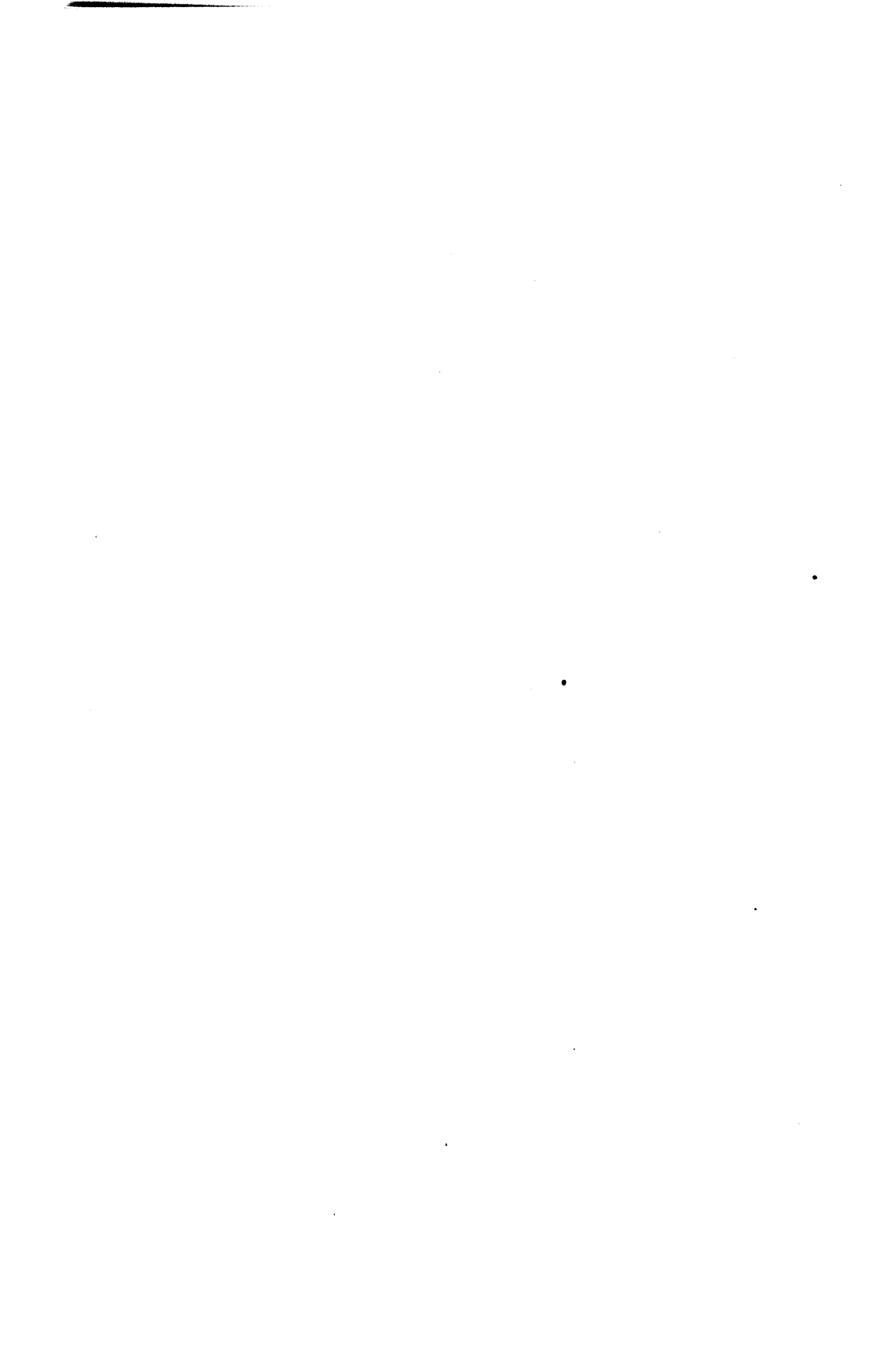
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relating to the transfer of certain trust funds of the
Maine Industrial School for Girls to the State Treasury.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The trustees of the Maine Industrial School for Girls shall
2 pay into the State treasury the principal sums of the trust
3 funds now held, or which may be held by them, for the
4 benefit of said school. Said funds shall be known by the
5 names now attached thereto, or which may be attached by
6 terms of gifts or bequests. The State Treasurer shall
7 semi-annually pay to the treasurer of said school a sum
8 equal to two and one-half per cent of said amount, to be
9 used for the benefit of said school in accordance with the
10 several terms of gifts or bequests, or as the trustees shall
11 from time to time determine.
