## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section I of Chapter 169 of the Special Laws of 1903 relating to the Young Women's Christian Association of Portland, Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 169 of the Special Laws

- 2 of 1903 is hereby amended by substituting for the word
- 3 "fifty" in the sixth line of said section the words 'one hun-
- 4 dred,' so that said act as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The Young Women's Christian Association of

- 6 the city of Portland, Maine, a corporation organized under
- 7 the laws of this State and located at said Portland in said
- 8 county of Cumberland is hereby authorized and empowered

- 9 to hold by deed, devise, bequest or otherwise, property, per-10 sonal and real to the amount of one hundred thousand dol-11 lars.'
  - Sect. 2. The acts and doings of the meeting of said cor-2 poration held on the twelfth day of May, in the year of our
  - 3 Lord nineteen hundred and two, are nereby ratified, con-
  - 4 firmed and declared to be legal and valid.
