STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend an act authorizing the county commissioners of Cumberland County to erect a county building in Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The first paragraph of Chapter two hundred
2 and thirteen of the Private and Special Laws of the year
3 one thousand nine hundred and three as amended by Chap-
4 ter three hundred and fifty-five of the Private and Special
5 Laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and five, and
6 as further amended by Chapter four hundred and thirty-
7 eight of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thou-
8 sand nine hundred and seven, is hereby amended by striking
9 out the word "eight" and inserting in lieu thereof the word

10 'nine,' so that said paragraph as amended, shall read as
11 follows:

The County Commissioners of the County of Cumber-
13 land are authorized to erect and maintain in the city of
14 Portland a county building of modern, fireproof construc-
15 tion, containing suitable court rooms, registries, county of-
16 fices, library rooms and such other rooms, accommodations
17 and conveniences as to such commissioners may seem nec-
18 essary or desirable, and for that purpose to acquire suit-
19 able land, either by purchase, exchange, or by taking as for
20 public uses, and in order to provide for the payment thereof
21 to borrow money and issue interest bearing bonds of said
22 county to an amount not to exceed in the aggregate nine
23 hundred and fifty thousand dollars and the rate of interest
24 on said bonds shall not exceed three and one-half per cent.
25 per annum. Said county commissioners shall cause any
26 land so taken to be surveyed, located and so described that
27 the same can be identified, and shall cause a plan and de-
28 scription thereof to be filed in their office and there re-
29 corded.

The filing of said plan and description shall vest the title
31 to said land in said county, or its grantees, to be held during
32 the pleasure of said county.

Said bonds shall be valid without first obtaining the con-
34 sent of said county as provided in sections fourteen and
35 sixteen of chapter eighty of the revised statutes.
