IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT amending the charter of the Maine Missionary Society.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:


Section 1. Chapter 526 of the Private and Special Laws,

- 2 approved on the 27th day of January, 1871, creating the
- 3 Maine Missionary Society is hereby amended by adding to
- 4 the first section of said act the following:

And said corporation is authorized to act as the custodian

- 6 or trustee of any church, parish or other religious body or
- 7 association, and to that end is authorized and empowered
- 8 to receive, take and hold by deed, devise, bequest, gift, or
- 9 otherwise, whether heretofore or hereafter made, property,
- 10 personal or real, to the amount in the aggregate of \$200,-

11 000.00: and for the accomplishment of such purposes, said 12 corporation is authorized and empowered to enter into con-13 tracts with such churches, parishes, religious bodies, asso-14 ciations or donors, as to the terms and conditions under 15 which such deeds, devises, bequests, and gifts are received 16 and held; and unless otherwise provided, the funds so re-17 ceived for the aforesaid purposes shall be deposited in such 18 Savings Banks or Trust Companies in the name of such cor-10 poration as its officers may determine upon; or invested in 20 such other property or securities as Savings Banks under 21 the laws of this State are allowed to invest in, to be from 22 time to time determined upon by said corporation; and such 23 properties, deposits or investments shall be so arranged as 24 to identify the particular fund and purpose for which the 25 same is received and held; and said corporation shall possess 26 all the rights, privileges and immunities, which belong to 27 corporations created for charitable objects, under the laws 28 of this State.
