IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes, relating
to inspector of factories, workshops, mines and quarries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-seven of chapter forty of the Re-
vised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out, in the
fourth and fifth lines of said section, the words "presented
by the commissioner." So that said section, when amended
will read as follows:

'Sect. 47. The expenses of the department, including all
bills for the expenses of the inspector of factories, work-

8 shops, mines and quarries, and for the services and expenses
9 of assistant inspectors shall be paid on vouchers after the
10 same shall have been audited and approved by the governor
11 and council.'
